A psychosocial hazard at work refers to any occupational issue that could cause psychological harm. Examples of this can include:

- ⑤ Workplace conflict
- ⑤ Issues with job demands or support
- ⑤ Bullying and harassment
- ⑤ Violence and aggression, or traumatic events.
